By filling in and signing this form, the prospective reviewer agrees to observe the following points:

1. The review should be written according to the usual standards of scholarship in Anglo-American studies. Apart from offering an accurate description of the contents of the book, the review should be a reasoned attempt at assessing its relative value and scope with reference to similar works in the same field. Therefore, a bibliographical revision of previous publications and a balanced judgement of the true contribution of the book under review should never be absent. Formal aspects such as style, layout, critical apparatus, reference system, etc. should also be attended to.
2. The review should closely follow the *Atlantis* Formal Guidelines to be found at the journal web site <<http://www.atlantisjournal.org>>. It should be between 2,500 and 3,000 words in length and be written in English.
3. The review should reach the General Editor within six months of receipt of the book. Reviewers are reminded that *Atlantis* only carries reviews of books which have appeared within three years of the date of submission of the review. It usually takes from four to six months to complete the whole process of assessment, proof-reading, and publication. So, as a safeguard, reviewers are recommended to order books only if they have appeared within the same year that they order them. Please make sure that the year of publication you enter in the appropriate box above is the original, "first-published" date.
4. Review copies of books donated by publishers remain the unrestricted property of AEDEAN until the review is formally accepted by the General Editor of *Atlantis*. Only then do they become the property of the reviewer. If the review falls below the usual scholarly standards and is finally rejected, the reviewer can make no claim as to the ownership of the book and must return it to the general Editor so that another review may be commissioned.
